Years ago at a trade show the USPS had a booth where they discussed the ability to do all this electronically. It got my attention. When the opportunity came to edit and publish the Hillholder, I used that service. Fortunately I could share all this technology with a new internet forum for Studebaker Newsletter editors. Henry Votel of the North Star Wheel read my post and decided to try it. Here is his flattering story.

In record time! I am done with my 8 page newsletter this month to 130 members out of 159 that get a paper version.

I "NEVER"

- Printed out a final version,
- Drove to the CopyMax Store for copies,
- Waited 20-30 minutes or came back another time for the copies,
- Sat down to collate the pages,
- Folded the newsletters,
- Labeled the newsletters,
- Placed first class stamps on the newsletters or had to get stamps,
- Bundled up the newsletters and took them to the Post Office.

*The cost savings helped too*


The costs for our Chapter's newsletter dropped from .99¢ to .70¢ each and that included postage! Not counting my time and gas expense. I'm going to give Don Smith a big hug if I ever meet him! There is a learning curve in doing this but if I can do it so can you. Go to the USPS site and give it a test run using an old newsletter that you mail to yourself. Samples of their various products can be mailed to you so you can see them. Ask questions here in the Forum if you have difficulties.


