



President's Message:



STUDEBAKER MUSEUM RECEIVES \$168,000 FEDERAL GRANT FROM SAVE AMERICA'S TREASURES

A South Bend museum that recently found itself a new home is picking up some new cash. The Studebaker National Museum is getting some financial help, after receiving a \$168,000 grant. The museum was one of 61 chosen for the Save America's Treasures Grant. The grant will be used to fund restoration of eight vehicles in the museum's National Treasures Collection. The Studebaker National Museum is located at 201 S. Chapin Street in downtown South

Bend. Hours of operation are Monday through Saturday, 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and Sunday 12:00 to 5:00 PM. Admission is \$8.00 for adults and \$6.50 for seniors over 60 and \$5.00 for youth ages 5 to 18. Annual membership fees are \$30.00 for seniors, \$40.00 for individuals, and \$60.00 for a family.
