The price of each meal is \$10.95. Drinks are extra. The dining area will be in a private setting. The restaurant is located at 118 North Wayne Street, Monroe, Georgia 30655. It is located in the Downtown District on the adjacent back street between North Highland and Spring Street. From Hwy.78 exit onto Hwy. 11 (Main Street) go south into the Historic District. Turn right on to Highland Ave. at the intersection just past St. Albans Episcopal Church & Monroe Utilities' Building; immediately turn left onto North Wayne Street. Delmonico's is located on the left. Parking is in front of the building or across the street. The telephone number for 678-247-3718.



## Different by Design




President's Message:
