

### DIRECTIONS TO LAKE ARROWHEAD

To the North Entrance (Farthest from the Clubhouse)-purple line on above map:

From the South, take Exit 16 (Canton Exit) from I-575, go left over the freeway to Highway 5 (Shell gas station and Williams Barbeque), and turn right. Go past Cherokee High School to the intersection of Hwys 5 and 140; turn left on 140. Go past Waleska approx 3 miles to Little Refuge Rd- you'll see the Lake Arrowhead sign. Turn left on Little Refuge Rd., go approx. 1 mile to Lake Arrowhead entrance.

### Lake Arrowhead DIRECTIONS

From the East, take Hwy 20 from Buford/Cumming area west into Canton. There are a couple of jogs in Canton, so bear right and then left past the county buildings down the hill. Go straight through past the Chevron station and the Walgreen Drugs, on what is now Hwy 140, heading for Waleska. Go past Waleska approx 3 miles to Little Refuge Rd- you'll see the Lake Arrowhead sign. Turn left on Little Refuge Rd., go approx. 1 mile to Lake Arrowhead entrance.

The clubhouse is at the other end of the complex. Go right at the first intersection after leaving the guardhouse, and continue past the small lake on Lake Arrowhead Road, past the second mailbox grouping and lookout. Continue past the Chapel to the third mailbox grouping. Turn left down the hill and you will see the lake, the Clubhouse and a bunch of Studebakers. To the South Entrance (Closest to the Clubhouse), arrows on map above:

Take SR 20 west out of Canton, turn right (North) on SR 108. The South Gate will be on your left. Inside the gate, turn left at the first intersection, go over the dam, and turn right at the first group of mailboxes. Go down the hill and you will see the lake, the Clubhouse and a bunch of Studebakers.




President's Message:
