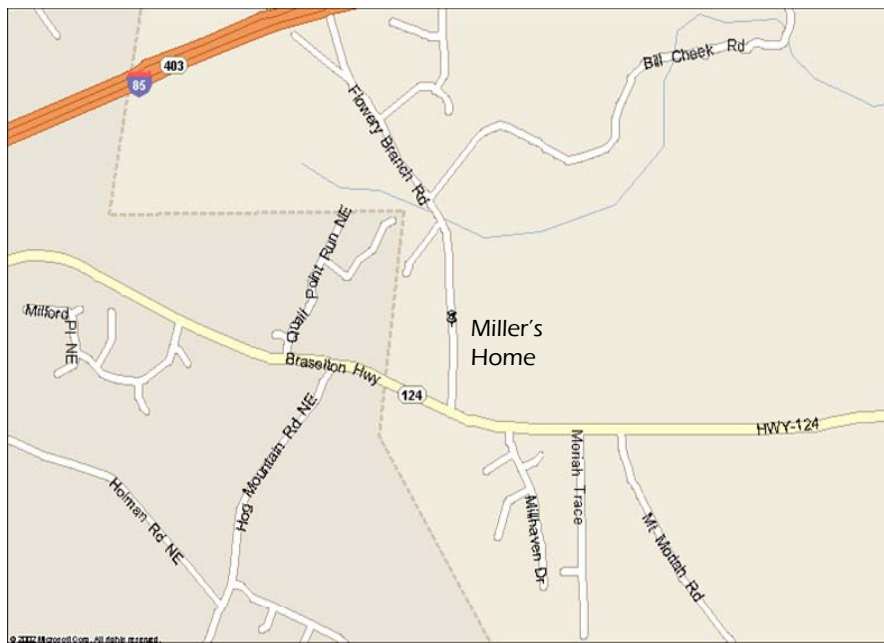

June Monthly Meeting will be a barbeque and cookout at Dan & Barbara Miller's home.

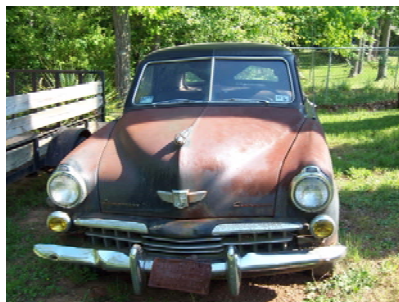

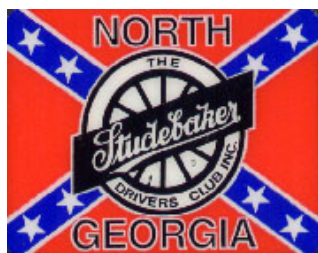

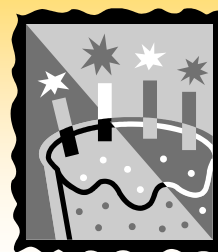
President's Message:
