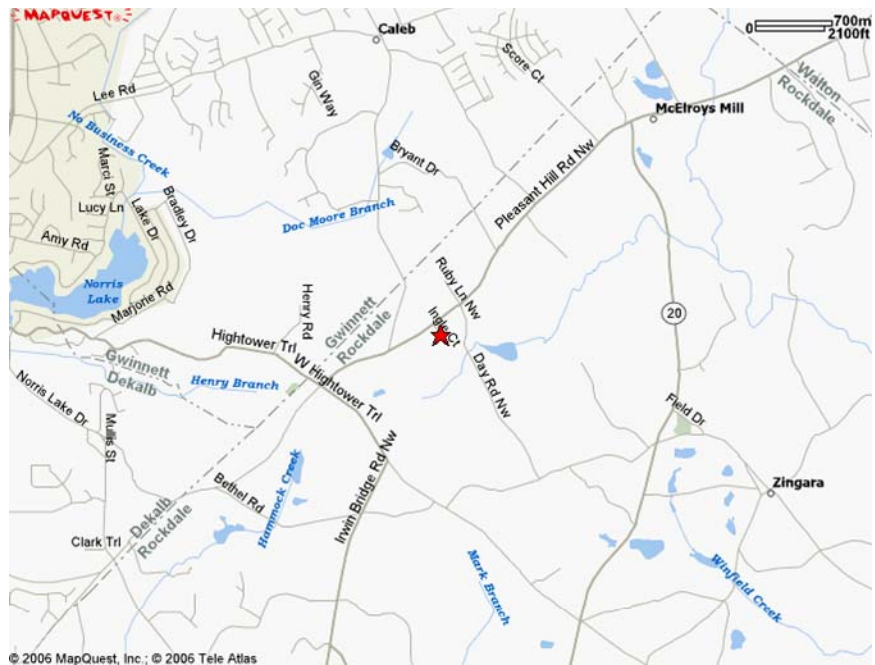

From I-285-Take Hwy 78 E to Snellville. Turn right on 124, go one block to Henry Clower. Turn left and go one block to Lenor Church Road. Turn right on Lenor Church Road. Follow Lenor Church Road until it dead ends (go through the 4 way stop at the park) into Pleasant Hill Road. Turn right and go 3/10 mile to 3rd road on left which is Ingle Court. Turn left and go to the end of the street.

From I-20- Exit 75 Turner Hill Road (Hwy 124). Go north towards Snellville approximately 2.5 miles.

Turn right onto Pleasant Hill Road (at the SHELL Food Mart). Go approximately...8 miles. Ingle Court will be the first street on the right after you go through the traffic light on Pleasant Hill Road. (770) 388-9151

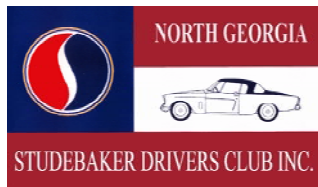

President's Message:

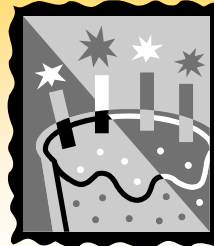
