Cream Cheese Pound Cake

3 cups Swans Down Cake Flour
3 sticks margarine

3 cups sugar
1 tsp vanilla

Cream together cream cheese and margarine. Add sugar and cream well. Add one egg at a time along with the flour until all is used. Add vanilla. Pour into a well greased and floured tube pan. Bake at 325 degrees for 1 hour and 45 minutes.

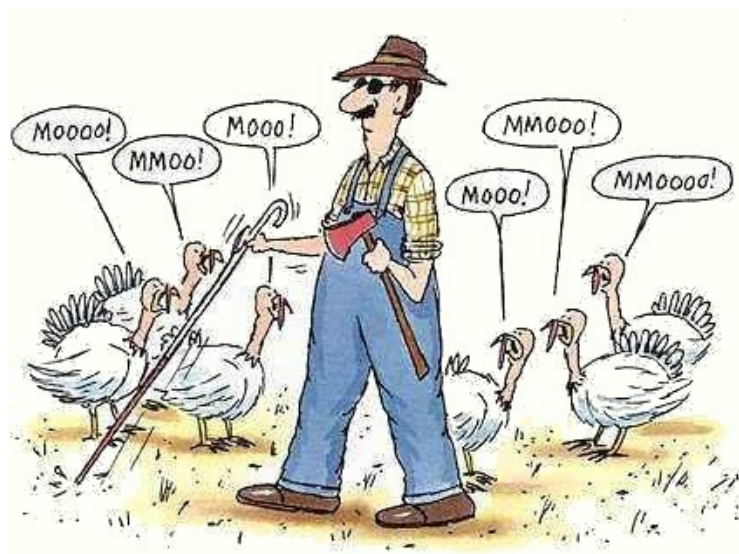

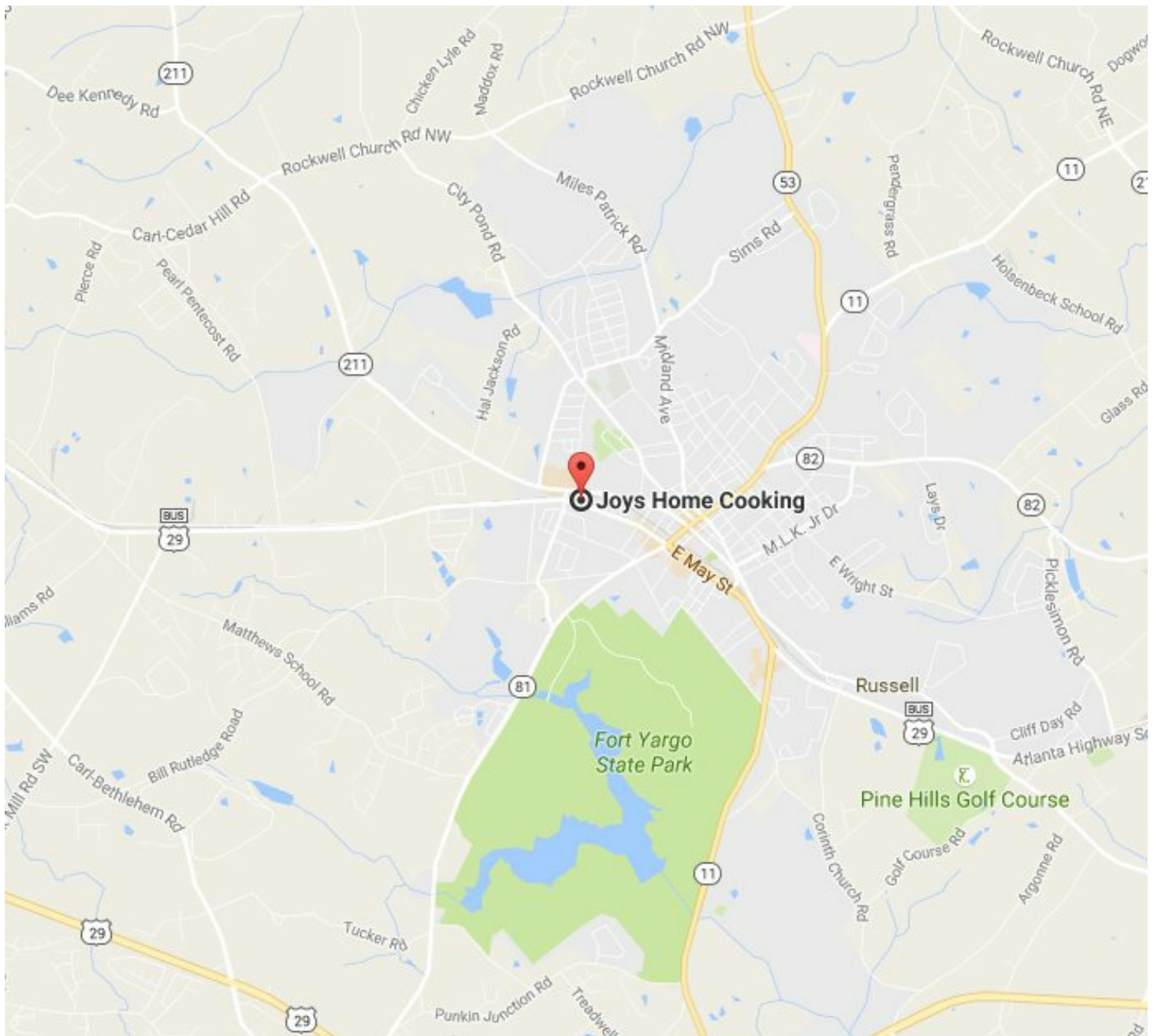

SOME THOUGHTS ON RESTORING A STUDEBAKER

Written by Chuck Lampman, this 99-page book is based on articles written by Chuck Lampman, North Georgia Chapter SDC member, that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990's and won the SDC Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-paid. Some material edited out of *Turning Wheels* is included in the book as well as updates and several new items written after the *Turning Wheels* series was published. "Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first time restorer but will be of value to the more experienced. It is not intended to be a "how to restore" book but gives a look at the decision-making processes, tools, spaces, and basic skills needed to do a restoration. It also provides a framework to help structure a project and contains several chapters of Studebaker-specific advice.
