Editor Commentary

My in-box has run out of recipes for our recipe corner, so I offer you the following recipe for crunchy, not chewy, chocolate-chip cookies to enjoy over the holidays. This recipe makes about 3 dozen cookies.

Chocolate-Chip Cookie Recipe

In a large mixing bowl, mix the following: (I start by using a wooden spoon and then end with an electric mixer.)

- 1/2 cup of shortening (ideally softened first)
- (You can also substitute butter for any or all of the shortening. I sometimes use half each.)
- 1/3 cup of granulated sugar
- 1/3 cup of packed brown (or light brown) sugar
- 1 teaspoon of vanilla
- 1 egg

In another bowl, mix the following dry ingredients:

- 1 cup plus 2 tablespoons of flour
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda
- optionally 1/2 teaspoon of salt

- Bit by bit, (not all at once), stir the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients.
- Each time you add some more dry ingredients to the wet ones, the mix becomes harder to stir.
- When all dry ingredients have been added, notice the consistency of the mix.
- If it's soft and gooey, continue adding flour.
- You want to end up with more of a paste that requires kneading by hand, not a wet mix.
- Finally, using your (very clean) hands, add a healthy amount of chocolate chips and knead them in.
- Some folks like to add walnuts or some other ingredient as well, so this is an option.
- Pre-heat your oven to 325 degrees.
- Roll the mix into ball shapes a bit larger than marbles.
- Place them on a cookie sheet covered with aluminum foil.
- (Do not grease or add anything else to the aluminum foil.)
- Bake them for about 10 to 12 minutes, but keep an eye on them because the time will vary from one oven to another.
- As they begin to turn brown, remove them from the oven and let them cool down before removing them using a spatula.

SOME THOUGHTS ON RESTORING A STUDEBAKER

Written by Chuck Lampman, this 99-page book is based on articles written by Chuck Lampman, North Georgia Chapter SDC member, that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990's and won the SDC Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-paid. Some material edited out of *Turning Wheels* is included in the book as well as updates and several new items written after the *Turning Wheels* series was published. "Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first time restorer but will be of value to the more experienced. It is not intended to be a "how to restore" book but gives a look at the decision-making processes, tools, spaces, and basic skills needed to do a restoration. It also provides a framework to help structure a project and contains several chapters of Studebaker-specific advice.
