Editor Comment

Who Am I?

Well, it's almost a new year, and this new year brings a new editor to the Hillholder. Many thanks to Charlotte Delli for doing such an excellent job in the past with this publication. She will certainly be a tough act to follow, but here I am, giving this my best shot. I am Tim Taylor, a 10-year member of this club. I am lucky enough to be married to my former Internet pen pal Guadalupe. We are in the 18th year of our long-term honeymoon.

My history with Studebakers is a rather short one compared with many of you. I did not grow up with Studebakers. My parents were focused on frugality, and their only interest in automobiles was to get from point A to point B as economically as possible. Consequently, I grew up with Nash Ramblers, Plymouth Valiants, and Simcas. Simcas? What are those? For anyone who doesn't already know, those were inexpensive little French cars marketed by Chrysler-Plymouth dealers for a while in the 1960s. Each of my parents drove one of those for two years. Having spent my childhood and early adulthood in northern Ohio, I recall many cold winter mornings when I would need to get up early and crank up my 1956 Ford to push one or both of those 1962 Simcas to get them started so that Mom and Dad could get to work. Anyway, I was always interested in cars. As a child, I had a collection of toy cars that I played with almost every day. I enjoyed studying and comparing all of the marques of the day, which included the Big Three as well as the cars of the independents like Kaiser-Frazer, Nash, Hudson, Studebaker-Packard, and Willys. I enjoyed being able to name the marque and year of any car on the road. I became a pest to the local automobile dealers because long before I was old enough to drive I would visit the dealerships and collect their sales literature.

I bought my first Studebaker about 18 years ago when I was in the market for a pickup truck that I could drive without concern for scratches and dents. It was a 1947 "Kenny's Clunkers" M5 that I found in Wisconsin. That truck needed work, and I eventually caved in and sold it to a friend who wanted it more than I did. Fast forward a few years, and I purchased my second Studebaker, also a pickup truck. This time, I found the truck on eBay and bought it without ever seeing or driving it, which is NOT something I recommend doing. Lady luck was with me, however, and my 1960 Champ turned out to be a great runner in excellent condition. (See photo to the left.) This remains my current Studebaker and my only Studebaker. It now has 42,000 original miles and is an unrestored but re-painted truck. I intend to keep it for as long as I am still able to drive it.

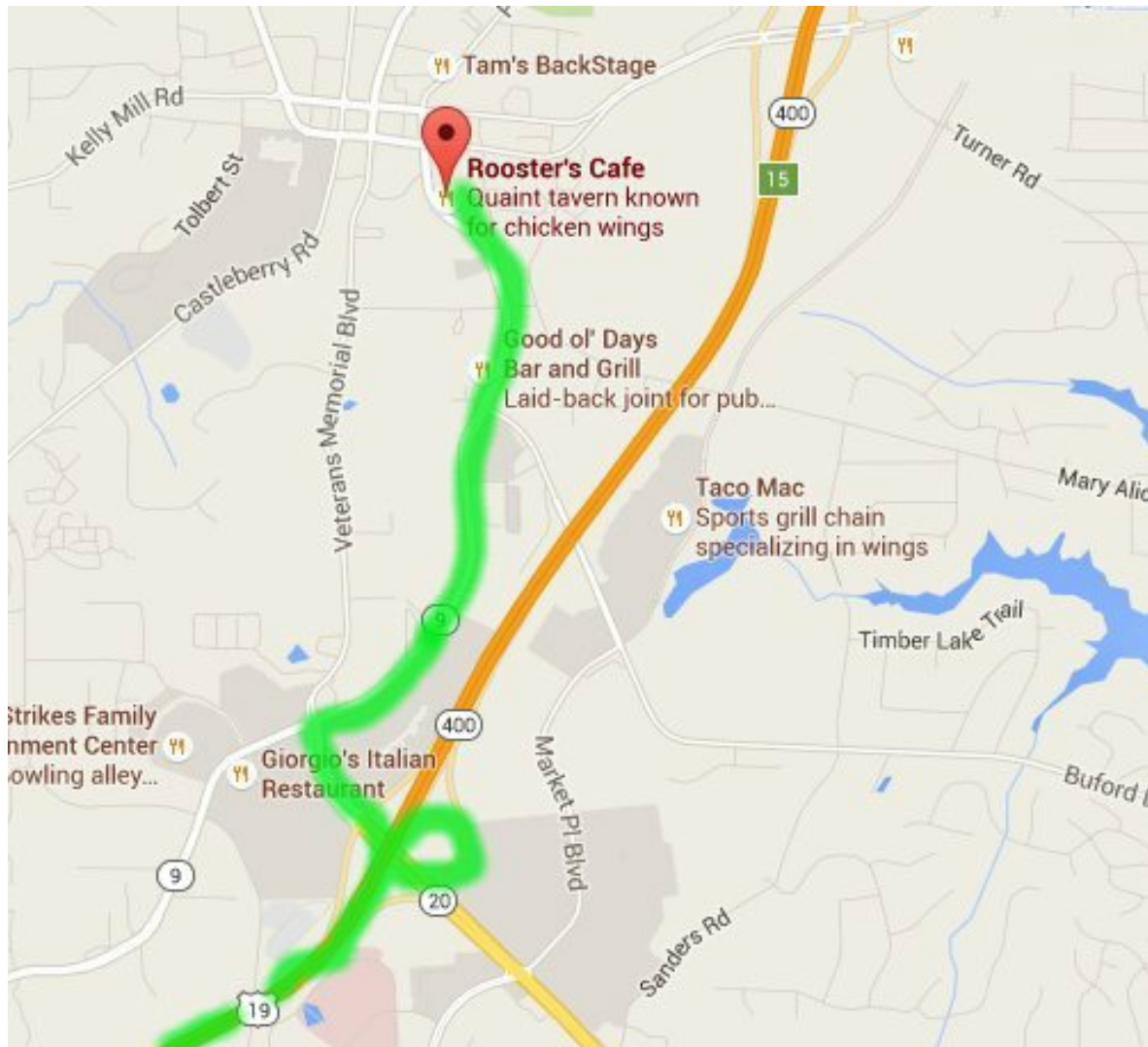

SOME THOUGHTS ON RESTORING A STUDEBAKER

Written by Chuck Lampman, this 99-page book is based on articles written by Chuck Lampman, North Georgia Chapter SDC member, that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990's and won the SDC Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-paid. Some material edited out of *Turning Wheels* is included in the book as well as updates and several new items written after the *Turning Wheels* series was published. "Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first time restorer but will be of value to the more experienced. It is not intended to be a "how to restore" book but gives a look at the

decision-making processes, tools, spaces, and basic skills needed to do a restoration. It also provides a framework to help structure a project and contains several chapters of Studebaker-specific advice.
