I spoke with Ann Lee this morning and she advised me that all of next year's monthly chapter meeting dates have volunteers, except for September. WAY TO GO NGC!!!



July 11, 2010

Guests today included: Jim and Donna Squire, who brought their 1988 Avanti convertible. The Malin's friends Ron and Kathy Brown were here, along with Tom and Maureen Elliott's family members: Jessica Lloyd, Alyssa, Austin, and Hailey Thomas.
- Dan spoke with Charleen Carey yesterday. She had her stent removed on Friday, and thought it prudent to stay home and rest over the weekend, rather than risk "pushing it" by coming to the meeting today. Charleen said she is coming along well since her last surgery, and she and Billy are looking forward to being with us at the August meeting.
- Earlier on Saturday, Dan and Barbara met with Alan and Rochelle Ziglin at the Dorothy Benson Senior Complex in Sandy Springs for an informal display of their cars for the seniors. This was in conjunction with the facility's antique appraisal and show day. The attendees really enjoyed seeing the cars, with the Ziglin's 1929 Commander in particular drawing lots of attention.
- Dan highlighted some of the other upcoming events of interest, including the Jefferson Lions Club show on August 14. Rick Kamen invited us to join in the Kaiser-Frazer Club's Dixie Region Fall Meet on October 1-3. - Dan had a couple of updates on the Southeast Zone Meet:
  - Along with the trophies for the vehicle judging, we will award prizes for the best vehicle decorated in the fall theme of the meet, and for the best scarecrow.
  - The meet hotel and the owners of the adjacent parking lot now have the information about our insurance coverage.
- Ed Burris recounted some highlights of his trip to the International Meet in Arizona. Ed truly expresses the *Driver* in Studebaker Drivers Club, taking his Avanti 4,900 miles to attend. On the return trip, he was able to stay ahead of the severe storms that struck the middle part of the country. Those who know Ed's enthusiasm for high-speed motoring can understand how he stays a jump ahead of the weather. Also:
  - Board member Tom Curtis has been allocated \$7,500 to develop some ads which the SDC can run in car enthusiast magazines, as another way to publicize the club.
  - A new color brochure along the lines of the "What's it all about" pamphlet is coming out.


- Tom and Maureen Elliott told us that Tom will be a patient in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase trial of stem cell replacement surgery. Assuming no issues are identified in pre-testing, Tom will be patient number six, with his surgery being performed at Emory on August 25. This is expected to be a four to seven day hospital stay, with the first day in the intensive care unit. The purpose of these patient trials is to confirm that the treatment is safe, determine the appropriate level of cells to use, and to document its effectiveness. The hope is that this regimen will be effective not only for ALS patients, but also for those with other conditions such as Alzheimer's which today have limited treatment options.

It is most courageous of Tom and Maureen to accept the risks and give of themselves in hopes of helping others. To provide an appropriate Studebaker send-off, Matthew Burnette will drive Tom's business coupe for the hospital trip. We will of course keep you up to date as we get closer to the surgery date.

Tom also is featured in a book being written about their town of Fayetteville; he is pictured wearing his Studebaker shop coat alongside his business coupe. The Danbury Mint released a 1:24 scale 1953 Commander Starliner, finished in Bombay Red and Salem White. 

## International Meet Report

Tuesday, July 06, 2010

I wanted to report back to you with some of the details on the National Meet in Glendale, Arizona. I see where several chapter publications have already covered many of the tours and fun events so I will limit my remarks to Board actions and meet statistics.

The Board meeting was held on Monday May 31, 2010. We started off with the usual committee reports. Cornerstone gave a membership report and noted that the new membership kept pace with the ones we lost. Bob Shaw is our current webmaster. He is stepping down so the position is open. It is a paid position. As many of you know Diane Glew is now in charge of the International Meet Committee. This is a very important position with all the expenses involved and the supervision of the facilities and numerous activities sponsored by the National organization and the chapter involved in the meet. Stepping into this meet in midstream created a number of challenges which she handled extremely well.

The Chief Judge talked about a certification program for Judges that he plans to implement in the near future. In fact I thought there were plans to start the program at our Zone Meet in Ontario.

As you know Dick Quinn is in possession of the Studebaker photo collection which covers the 1920's and 1930's. With the problem of old negatives there was talk of beginning a program to digitize the collection to preserve them from disintegration.

We are also looking for a new person to handle the Template collection. This project has been handled by Dick Mottle for many years.

Peter Crisitello came up with a program to salute all the recently deceased members in SDC. He had a wonderful display in the vendor hall honoring those recently departed. This was a fitting tribute. This will be an annual event.

The Studebaker Museum in South Bend gave a brief update on activities and pointed out that they still have a number of cars in the Museum that can be singled out under the Adopt-a-Car program. By adopting a car you can help sponsor the maintenance and upkeep of a particular vehicle.

We also agreed to donate \$5,900.00 to the Museum for a project under the Capital Cost campaign. We are now looking for a Chairman for this committee after the untimely demise of Phil Brown.

The National Foundation reported their financial status and noted that they are still helping students with tuition whose major in college is the restoration of automobiles. They also support the restoration of Studebaker vehicles held in other museums. This is another way of keeping the marquee in the public eye.

There was also an extensive plan headed by Director Tom Curtis to recruit new members. More details on this to follow.

The big discussion at the Board meeting was a dues increase. After many discussions and suggestions the Board finally decided to increase the regular dues to \$31.00 effective December 31, 2010. They also noted that you can only prepay at the old rate for an additional year and not five years. Since the meet the Board has approved other changes which will be published in Turning Wheels.

I voted against raising the dues. It is not because of the amount held in the reserve account because that has been designated for future projects and not because a dues increase would not be needed some time in the future but because I felt there were other cost cutting measures they could have invoked this year to save expenses and these reductions were not considered by the Board. There is no question however, that Turning Wheels is a bargain even at \$31.00.

Tom Curtis, Jane Stinson and I have been asked to set up an Investment Committee to keep a watchful eye on the balance in the reserve fund. I want to insure that we maintain a conservative approach to the protection of the funds.

47<sup>th</sup> in Springfield, Missouri June 19-June 25, 2011.

48<sup>th</sup> in South Bend, Indiana July 29-Aug 4, 2012.

49<sup>th</sup> in Colorado Springs, Colorado June 1-June 6, 2013.

50<sup>th</sup> in Dover Downs, Delaware June 30-July 5, 2014.

Elections – all National Officers remain the same except for the position of Vice President. Richard Dormois has retired as Vice President after nine years of service to the club. In his place we elected Carl Thomason of Coarsegold, California.
