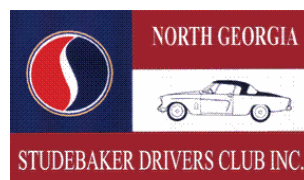
I look forward to seeing all of you on November 2, so please take care and drive safely.

## Meeting Minutes

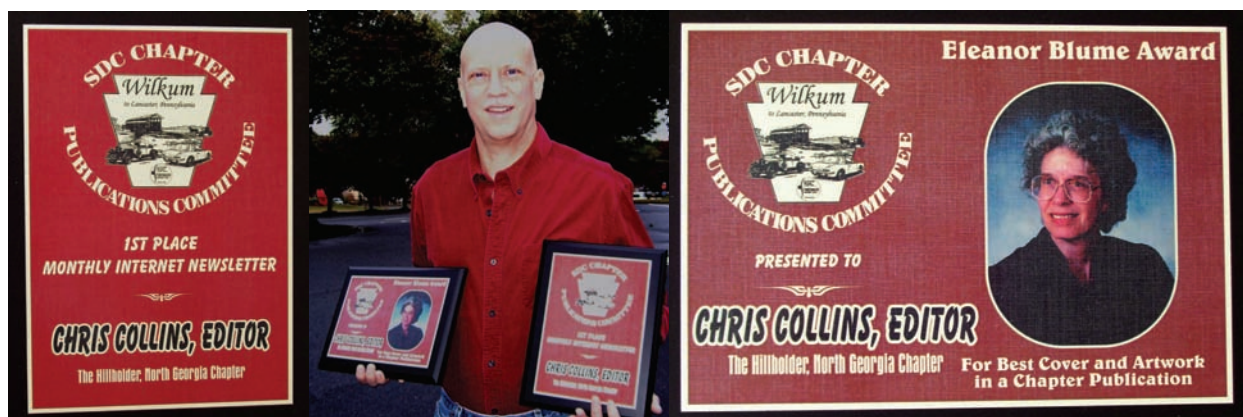
October 5, 2008

- Ed Burris gave us some updates:
  - At the International Meet, a situation arose in which one vendor stole some valuable parts from a fellow vendor in the swap meet area. Fortunately, the individual was caught, and SDC National is working through the matter to determine what the consequences shall be.
  - Also at Lancaster, several Studebaker owners reported camshaft failures after as little as a few thousand miles of use with the now zinc-free motor oils. ZDDPlus is a zinc additive that restores proper compatibility of current motor oil formulations with our older engines. ZDDPlus is sold by several Stude vendors. Ed bought a supply for his own use, and will pass on a bottle to members for \$10. More product information can be found at <http://www.zddplus.com/>.
  - The Speedometer Service Company in Roswell has closed after many years in our area. One of the firm's long-time employees is continuing with his own business, and the announcement flyer will be in *The Hillholder*.
- Wayne Lee gave us a recap of attendance levels at Lancaster. As the week progressed, it became clear that this was another very successful International Meet. Wayne's report will also be in *The Hillholder*.
- Charlotte Delli reported on the following:
  - Including today's new members, we have a total of 66 member households, representing 122 people.

## The November Chapter Meeting will be at The Bay Creek Church Community House

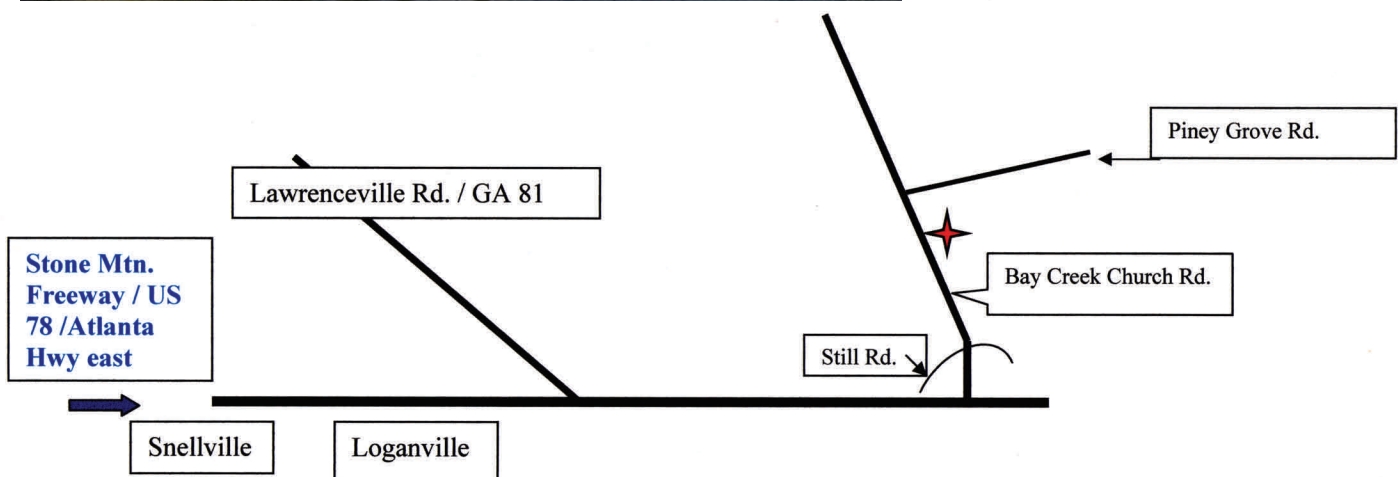
**When:** Sunday, November 2, at 2:00 PM.

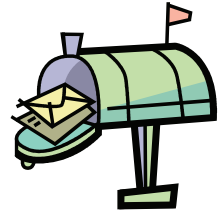

## Spiced Pecans

1 lb. pecan halves  
 1 egg white  
 1 tablespoon water  
 1 cup sugar  
 ½ tsp salt  
 ¼ tsp cinnamon

Preheat oven to 300 degrees.

Mix sugar, salt & cinnamon in a small mixing bowl & set aside.

In a second bowl, beat egg whites and water until frosty (not stiff).

Pour pecans into egg white mixture and stir until well coated.

Add in the sugar mixture and stir until well coated.

Spread Pecans on a foil lined cookie sheet.

Bake on middle rack for 30-40 minutes (after 15 minutes stir and turn over the nuts with spatula - mixture will be gooey - and return to the oven).

After 40 minutes, remove from oven and cool.

Note: Gas stoves might require less time.

### Zone Coordinator's Report 2008 International Meet - Lancaster, PA

Raw statistics for SDC International Meet 2008 in Lancaster, PA: 785 registrations, 1,541 people, 462 cars, 643 attended the SDC-sponsored Welcome Night free banquet, and 594 signed-up for the Friday night Awards Banquet (when we checked on Thursday).

I attended a portion of the SDC Board Meeting and also the meeting of Presidents, Regional Managers and Zone Coordinators - chaired by Ed Reynolds and Richard Dormois, SDC President and Vice President, respectively. My notes follow.

The SDC has a lot of \$\$\$ in the bank and the Board has been busy authorizing that some of it be returned to the members in various ways.

For the first time ever, the SDC sponsored a free dinner during member Welcome Night on Monday. They anticipated about 300 would show and 643 actually walked through the doors. The value of that meal was said to be about \$17.95 per person.

They have also authorized more frequent use of color in *Turning Wheels* at no charge to the members. SDC Int'l Meet registration charges are being dropped from \$30 to \$20 and will permit the member + spouse + 2 guests to attend the meet. Int'l Meet car show judging fees were dropped from \$15 to \$10 and display cars are now free. Non-registered swap meet attendees will be charged a \$5 entrance fee.

There are 3 levels of SDC membership now: \$10 (no *TW*), \$19.95 first time member (with *TW*), and the \$27.95 regular memberships.

SDC has also revamped their SDC and Chapter Officer Liability Insurance program at no added cost to the members. The new carrier is J.C. Taylor.

The free t-shirt program to recognize the 21 and under meet participants continues. Joe Roberts in North Carolina administers this program: 910.484.2512; [itraseecab@aol.com](mailto:itraseecab@aol.com).

The Board also voted to send every RM/ZC & Chapter President a brand new national roster and a copy of the newly revised *Studebaker Inside Facts 2008* - no charge to the members.



The SDC has also republished the *Studebaker Story* pamphlet. These can be had free for the asking from Richard Dormois - SDC VP. His idea is that all members have a couple of these in their cars to hand out to potential new members. Also, chapter presidents can get in touch with Mark Wheeler (SDC registrations) and request a box of back issue *Turning Wheels* - to be divided among chapter members specifically for recruiting purposes - again authorized by the SDC Board - at no cost to members.

I just wanted to pass along how much we enjoyed this year's SDC meet at Lancaster, Pa. Also some interesting experiences on our return trip. The SDC and the Keystone Region Chapter put on an excellent meet. We were pleased to see such a good turnout considering the economy and gas prices. We drove our "60 Hawk" a total of 1,440 miles and it ran flawlessly the entire time. We entered it in the class 8 modified division and received 366 points in the scoring for one of the second place plaques. We missed a first place plaque by 9 points. But we'll work on the demerits and see if we can do better next time we are judged under the SDC point system. We made a number of stops on the return trip at Gettysburg, Antietam, Harpers Ferry, VMI and the George C. Marshall museum/library located there, and finally at Bristol, Tennessee to tour the Bristol (NASCAR) Motor Speedway. Carol and I are interested in Civil War and WWII history along with being NASCAR fans as you may have guessed.

We had planned a day at Asheville and the Biltmore Estate. But as we arrived at Asheville we found huge gas lines and many stations without any gas at all. They were charging \$4.19 and up per gallon where you could get it. The highest price we saw on the way up to Lancaster was \$4.49 per gallon. The lowest we saw was at Lancaster for \$3.77 per gallon. We did not have enough gas to make it back to Blue Ridge from the Asheville area. It was miles before we found a Sunoco station in Sylva, North Carolina that had gas at \$3.99 per gallon. We had maybe 4 or 5 gallons left. I had driven a long way at only fifty miles per hour to preserve gas and it probably paid off. The Hawk isn't an economy car as far as gas consumption is concerned. You don't realize how helpless you can be until something like that happens while traveling. The rest of the trip to Blue Ridge was uneventful. This morning Carol went to the post office to pick up our mail and saw three of our larger Blue Ridge stations out of gas completely. I'll bet it was worse around the Atlanta metro area.

So our trip was a great and exciting experience with fellow Studebaker drivers and an opportunity to enjoy other places of interest along the way.

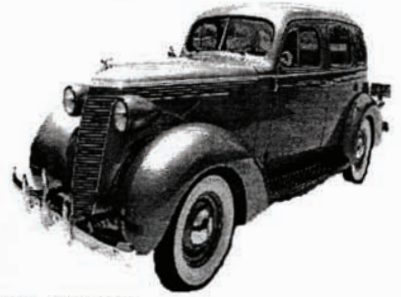

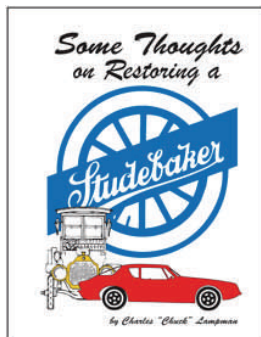

I finally finished it! This is a 99 page book I've put together based on the articles of the same name that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990s and which won the SDC's Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-Paid. The book contains all the material from the original series, which ran for a year and a half in *The Hillholder*, and not only replaces some material edited out for the *TW* series, but has updates and several new items that were written after the *TW* series was published.

"Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first-time restorer, but will be of value to the more experienced; it doesn't try to be a "how to restore a car book", but gives you a look at the decision-making processes, tools, spaces and basic skills you'll need to do a restoration, and will provide a framework to help you structure your project.

There are several chapters of Studebaker-specific advice. In the chapter devoted to engine rebuilding, I've tried to describe a step-by-step process that anybody can follow, and included tips I've picked up in building 60+ engines. I've received many compliments on the engine chapter, and I'm glad to finally be able to get it in print.
