## Meeting Minutes

April 12, 2008

- President Barbara Miller opened the meeting. A special welcome to members Ed & Del Lane, whom we have not seen for a while. We are pleased that Jerry Forrester and Sam Ensley have re-joined our chapter. Former member Richard Forgay, now in the South GA chapter, was also with us.
- Recognized April birthdays and anniversaries. Barbara read the note from John & Dorothy Brown, thanking the chapter for the flowers we sent to John. Please keep John close by in your thoughts and prayers, as his condition has become quite delicate.
- Barbara mentioned the new registry that has been set up for 1961 Hawks, as mentioned in the April *Hillholder*, page 5.
- We have been asked if our chapter wants to host a 2009 Georgia State Meet. This will be discussed more in the future.
- Treasurer Charlotte Delli presented the chapter financial results for the month of March. Charlotte paid \$23.00 to BB&T Bank for new checks; the chapter will reimburse her for this outlay. Charlotte reported a lot of activity so far during April, with several renewals and one new member.
- Charlotte recently learned that the member name badges have not been delivered from the vendor; she will follow up on that. She will also order some badges that attach with pins, for those who use medical devices which are sensitive to magnetism.
- Sample club calling cards of various finishes have been prepared for review and final selection. We agreed to add a brief slogan below the name on the cards, to better present the chapter's mission to prospective members. We will conduct a chapter slogan contest; more details to come at a future meeting.
- So far, Charlotte has no subsequent volunteers for the committee we set up at the March meeting, to explore alternative uses for the surplus funds in our bank account. Chuck Lampman volunteered to join Charlotte and John Hollier in this endeavor. We still need a couple more volunteers! If she does not hear from anyone else in the next few weeks, Charlotte will begin calling some members to solicit their assistance.
- Chuck requested that the chapter pay \$25.00 to Mark Van Deventer for hosting our website. Mark graciously provides this service as a courtesy to us and a number of other chapters. Motion made, seconded, and approved by all members present at the meeting.
- Chuck was able to sell several of our 2007 State Meet t-shirts on eBay. We have one size XXL remaining, and nine Mediums. We will have those for sale at the May meeting.
- Chris Collins relayed a request from Rick Kamen for volunteers to help during the day of the Orphan Car Show. Having put on this event for 16 years now, Rick is also seeking someone to lead this event in future years. Rick's letter will be in the next *Hillholder*.
- Chris also mentioned that the 2008 membership roster will go out to members this month. Our Chapter By-Laws will be modified to reflect the change we approved last month (allowing the President to be an alternative signatory on the bank accounts). Chris will send the modified By-Laws to the SDC Chartering Committee. Once approved, the amended By-Laws will be published in The *Hillholder*.

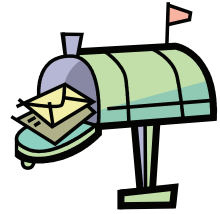

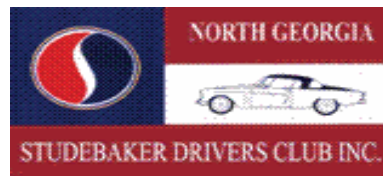

### History of Studebaker

(source: 1966 Model Year Introduction Press Kit)

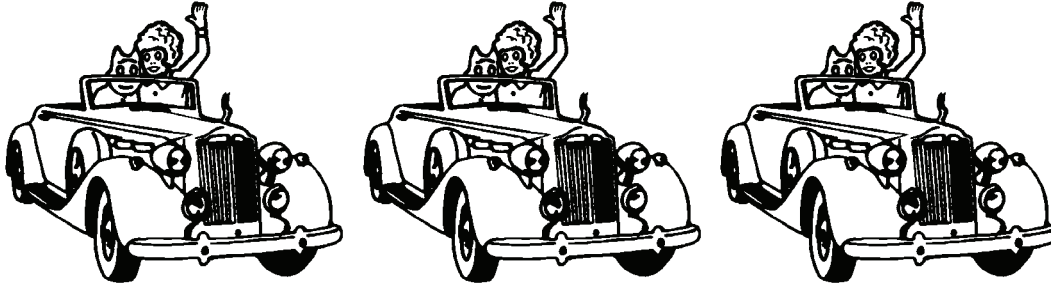
- 1955: Studebaker became a separate division of the corporation August 28, with Harold E. Churchill as general manager.
- First public demonstration and use of interlocking safety door latches to keep doors closed under impact. First complete line of 5-passenger sports-type cars by an American car maker...the Hawks.
- 1956: First factory-installed non-slip, power-dividing differentials for trucks (the Twin-Traction differential).
- First overdrive transmissions available throughout light and medium duty truck fields.
- First to use flared fin brake drums to minimize "fading" due to heat.
- First passenger car to use acoustical sound-deadening headlining.
- First to bring large displacement, high compression engines to the low price field in the 352 cubic inch V-8 engine rated at 275 horsepower.
- Harold E. Churchill elected President, Studebaker-Packard Corporation, August 6, following signing of the management advisory agreement with Curtiss-Wright Corporation.

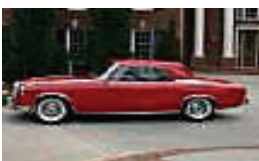

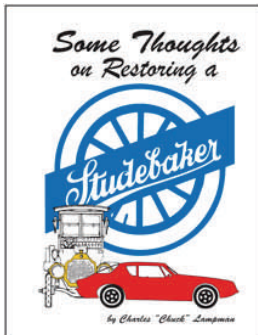
